THE RANEE TUAK & NATURAL SPRING SALT

The Ranee Tuak is a traditional rice wine indigenous to the natives of the Borneo state of Sarawak, Malaysia. Home brewed by fourth generation brewers, originating from the village of Banting, Sri Aman Division, it is a popular drink among the Dayaks during ceremonial and special occasions.

Extracted from salt springs located in the Bario Highlands of Sarawak, this rare salt is highly sought after due to its high natural mineral content. Ideal for cooking and as table salt.
